Included are several items we want to share with you and some forms which we would like you to complete and return to us:

- Registration Form:** Please complete the registration forms and send them along with your check to Bali Institute, P.O. Box 867, Sausalito, CA 94966. If you are paying online with PayPal, please send the forms or fax them to 415-331-7532. Full payment is due upon registration. Your registration will not be complete until payment is received.
- Terms & Conditions:** We must receive a signed copy of the Terms and Conditions. Your registration will not be complete until it is received.
- Medical Form:** It is important that we understand any special needs that travelers have regarding their health and safety while in Bali. Every effort will be made to accommodate all of your health concerns. Please complete the attached medical form and send it back to us as soon as possible.
- PODS:** We will be dividing into small dialogue groups on days two and three of the gathering. These groups will be based on your own interest in specific areas of global activism. We have included a list of these "pod communities". Please indicate your first and second choices so that you can be placed in a group that reflects your own particular interests. We will try to accommodate your primary selection.
- Travel Insurance:** Even though you may be covered by your personal medical insurance, we recommend that you purchase travel insurance, which can cover you in the event of trip cancellation or trip interruption. We recommend *CSA Travel Insurance*. Contact information can be found on our web site or by calling our travel affiliate, Pacific Harbor Travel at 1-800-435-9463.
- Special Ubud Medical Assistance Coverage:** We have arranged with the Ubud Medical Clinic to provide on-site medical assistance during the conference for a fee of \$30. **All attendees are required to purchase this coverage.** The Ubud Medical Clinic will provide 24-hour care for any number of travel-related ailments or minor medical emergencies. Please read the information in your registration packet. Fees collected go toward providing new equipment for the Ubud Medical Clinic and free health care for local Balinese.

Homestays are rooms in family compounds. Bungalows are separate cottages within a compound. Balinese hotels and villas are also available for the regular registration rate plus an additional hotel/villa accommodation charge starting at \$400/8 nights double occupancy. Hotels are lovely Balinese-style, with full amenities and beautifully landscaped grounds and swimming pools. Villas are 5-star hotels with private pools, gorgeous views and breakfast served by your private pool patio. All hotel, villa and air reservations, as well as travel extension possibilities before or after the Gathering dates, can be booked through **Pacific Harbor Travel**.

Hotel and air fare refunds/cancellations are at the discretion of **Pacific Harbor Travel** and are separate from the registration fee refunds.

Reservations and Payment

To reserve a space, please submit the registration form along with the full amount of the registration fee. Payment can be made by check payable to the Bali Institute for Global Renewal and sent to Bali Institute, PO Box 867, Sausalito, CA 94966. Any returned checks are subject to a \$30 fee. Credit card payments can be made via PayPal on the Bali Institute web site (www.baliinstitute.org). Any fees associated with hotels (other than homestays or private bungalows—double occupancy), extension trips, separate activities not listed on the registration materials and air fare must be handled separately and are not included in the Bali Institute registration fees.

Included in the Conference Fee

The conference fee includes airport transfer one-way from Denpasar to the attendee's Ubud-based accommodations (if air/hotel purchased through Pacific Harbor Travel); homestay or private bungalow (double occupancy) if selected; welcome reception, eight breakfasts, five lunches; all general conference activities and general workshops, performing arts and conference materials.

Not Included in the Conference Fee

Any visa fees are not covered. Arrival visa fees of approximately US\$25 are not included. A departure tax of approximately 100,000 rupiah (US \$11) upon leaving Indonesia is not included. Other charges not included are excess baggage fees; laundry; telephone calls and other personal expenses; alcoholic beverages; meals not specified in the itinerary; academic credit; tips; medical costs; insurance. Air travel to and from Bali, hotel/villa accommodations, and pre or post-conference programs, trips or activities are also not included.

Accommodations and Single Supplements

Homestay and private bungalow accommodations have been carefully selected for your stay in Ubud, Bali. If a traveler selects this type of accommodation (which is included in the basic conference package), please note that these are double occupancy and are located within local Balinese family compounds. Single room accommodations are also available for an additional fee. Smoking in the room is not permitted if your roommate is a non-smoker.

Cancellation and Refund policy

Cancellations must be received by the Bali Institute in writing by letter to Bali Institute for Global Renewal, P.O. Box 867, Sausalito, CA 94966 or by fax to (415)331-7532. Refunds will be based on the day we receive such written notification. Regardless of cause, cancellations result in additional administrative and processing costs, record adjustments, refund checks and other fees. The following penalties will apply on any cancellation handled by the Bali Institute:

Minimum non-refundable cancellation fee: \$500

31 – 90 days prior to departure: Lose 50% of registration price

0 – 30 days: Lose 100% of registration price

The Bali Institute cancellation policy does not cover any charges made to vendors associated with this trip including airfare, extension packages, hotels/villas, and other separately-arranged activities. Cancellations fees apply whether caused by the traveler or by another party. No partial refund will be given once the trip has begun. Please note that we highly recommend trip insurance.

Cancellation Insurance

Bali Institute is not responsible if your trip is cancelled for any reason, or for such expenses as airline cancellation fees, visa fees, vaccinations, purchases of clothing and equipment for the conference or other expenses. Materials on travel insurance will be sent once we have received your fees. We strongly urge that you consider taking out insurance, which may protect you in the event of unforeseen cancellations. Documents

All travel documents will be mailed to you 21 days prior to travel provided these terms and conditions have been signed and on file with us prior to that time.

Passports and Visas

Indonesia requires that all those seeking entry into the country have a passport that is valid for at least six month beyond your stay in Indonesia. Indonesia allows those holding passports from many countries, including the U.S., to obtain a visa when entering Indonesia for a fee of approximately US\$25. In many countries, a visa must be obtained before arriving in Indonesia. It is the responsibility of each traveler to determine his or her need to obtain an Indonesian visa in advance.

Responsibilities

Bali Institute for Global Renewal and all sponsoring organizations, booking agencies, their staffs and agents act only as agents for the suppliers in regard to travel, whether by airplane, motor coach, motor car, railroad or boat, and assume no liability for injury, damage, loss, accident, delay or irregularity which may be occasioned either by reason of defect or of any company or person engaged in conveying the passenger, or in carrying out the arrangements for the trip. They accept no responsibility for losses or additional expenses due to delays or changes in air or other services, sickness, weather, strike, war, terrorism, quarantine, force majeure or other causes. The right is reserved to substitute accommodations of similar or better quality for those indicated. The issuance and acceptance of voucher or ticket and/or payment and/or written acceptance of these terms and conditions shall be deemed to be consent to the above conditions. Transformative Education, Social & Political Leadership

“World-mindedness” is no longer a luxury, but a necessity for survival in this new century. Diverse viewpoints and perspectives are critical for this generation of constructive change on a global scale. Pioneering global facilitators in this pod will connect around their shared commitment to making a difference in education, social services and political agendas and thereby initiate the transformation of perspectives and worldviews toward a sustainable, compassionate world.

Language of the Soul: Spirituality, Healing, Medicine, and Indigenous Wisdom

The majority of religions and cultural traditions consider disease and illness to be a fundamental part of the human condition. Spiritual factors associated with healing are increasingly being acknowledged. Illness is beginning to be deeply understood as a unique language to awakening or consciousness. This pod will explore healing, medicine, spirituality and indigenous wisdom as doorways to global healing as well as a tool for activism.

Media as Activism: Innovation, Art, Film, Journalism, Performance and Visual Arts

This pod will explore how current and future art, performances and the use of media technology affect our world-view, senses and global cultural values.

The emergence of a global civil society based upon partnership principles is now considered one of the real hopes to democratize the global political economy. Deep Ecology, Environment and Sustainability Advocacy

The Balinese emphasis on the relationship between humanity, the environment and spirituality is a model for our deep inquiry. About the Ubud Medical Clinic Services

Following are the medical services, benefits and coverage available with your \$30 fee to the Ubud Medical Clinic for the following dates only: July 31-August 7, 2007. This coverage is required for all attendees. Please include payment with your registration fees.

Benefits:

1. Ubud Clinic covers medical expenses for outpatient medical services only.
2. Ubud Clinic includes:
 - 24-hour emergency assistance
 - 24-hour medical consultation (clinic or hotel visit or by phone)
 - 24-hour ambulance service
 - 24-hour pharmacy
 - Dentist assistance
 - Laboratory services
 - X-ray services
4. Outpatient medical assistance coverage is for the period of August 1-8, 2007
5. Medical assistance will be provided in two places:
 - Ubud Medical Clinic in Ubud
 - In-house medical clinic set up at ARMA Museum
6. If a person needs further examination or consultation that can't be provided in the Ubud Clinic, Ubud Clinic will organize the examination at their associate hospital. Ubud Clinic will pay the first 500,000 rupiah (approximately US\$50.00) of the total medical expenses of this exam. The rest of the medical expenses will be patient responsibility.

Not covered by this medical plan:

1. Outpatient and inpatient treatments not provided by Ubud Clinic
2. All types of alternative medicines (acupuncture, herbal medicines, etc.)
3. All types of chronic diseases (i.e. heart failure, kidney failure, liver problems, hypertension, etc.)
4. Any medical assistance for cosmetic purposes
5. Congenital conditions
6. Birth control, treatment of impotence, sterilization, abortion
7. Hazardous or professional sports
8. Intentionally self-inflicted injury, suicide, abuse of alcohol, drug addiction, or STDs
9. Prosthesis, orthotic devices, or corrective devices
